Dear Friends of CWWCHC,

It is with great joy and enthusiasm that I write to you on behalf of The C. W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc. (CWWCHC) to share information on our new medical facility construction project. As we celebrate over 45 years of providing high quality healthcare and support services to the community, this project honors our past while we build and prepare for our future. Indeed, CWWCHC is in a dynamic phase in our history. In addition to the opening of our new medical facility, we have experience significant staff growth, expanded our mobile medical and dental programs, increased HIV testing and treatment services, launched a Maternal & Child Health initiative, and established a Family Medicine Residency teaching program. Our future is auspicious, and we are inspired by the hard work, vision, and faith of our founders who insisted on equitable care for all.

Today, we carry that vision forward. As a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC), designated Patient-Centered Medical Home (PCMH), and healthcare safety net, CWWCHC fills a unique role in reducing burdens on hospitals by providing high quality, culturally sensitive services for more than 13,000 unique patients annually who come to us from throughout Mecklenburg and surrounding counties. Many of these patients face cultural, economic, and geographical challenges to accessing the care they and their families need. Often, they have no health insurance and are living in poverty. Some even have to choose between eating, seeing a doctor, or paying for life-saving medication. Unfortunately, our mainstay building located at 3333 Wilkinson Boulevard suffered numerous site and infrastructure issues that negatively impacted the patient experience and threatened patient and staff safety. To address these issues and position our organization for future growth, our leadership and Board of Directors have embarked on a capital project to construct a 17,700 square foot, state-of-the-art medical facility.

Now more than ever, the healthcare landscape is shifting and CWWCHC's must pivot with this change. Our patients and our staff deserve a facility that has sound, safe, and reliable infrastructure. They also deserve to reap the benefits of medical technology that is on par with other medical practices. With our new medical facility, CWWCHC will be able to support increased patient capacity while attracting world-class providers who share our vision of quality care for everyone, regardless of their background or financial circumstances. Scheduled to open August 2024, the new facility also will help improve the overall health of our community and increase affordable services available for our most vulnerable populations. What began as an \$8 million construction project has evolved into an \$11.6 million undertaking, due in no small part to delays and supply shortages experienced during the COVID-19 pandemic. Our community is stepping forward to help make the new medical facility a reality, but we also need your help. Our wish is to create a public and enduring record of our generous supporters. Accordingly, select areas of the future facility have been earmarked for commemorative and memorial naming purposes. For your review, attached is a proposal summarizing the project and naming opportunities. These opportunities represent the chance for you to help write a remarkable chapter in our organization's story, thereby becoming a significant part of our community's legacy for years to come.

At this time, we therefore respectfully ask for your consideration of support through a naming opportunity and would like to schedule a time a meet with you to review the legacy options.
